An autosomal dominant mutation in NF1 results in hyperactivation of the RAS pathway leading to the development of multiple tumors in different organs and increased risk of malignancies. NF1 is a progressive disorder involving many organs and systems. Symptoms develop and progress with age and clinical course varies between individuals. Currently, there is no causative treatment for NF1. Patients require multidisciplinary health care, regular follow-up considering the increased risk of malignancies.
